1	Pony Club Novice – Open to Pony Club Members only. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 70cm except for brush. Open to horses that have no BHT Points, or won more than £30 in any similar event or have not been placed first second or third on more than three occasions.	£30
2	Restricted Novice – Open to members of any BHS Affiliated Riding Club or BHS Gold Members. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 70cm except for brush. Open to horses that have no BHT Points, have not attended Area Horse Trails or won more than £30 in any similar event or have been placed first second or third on more than three occasions. Trophy to the winner.	CRC - £30 Non-members - £35
3	Open Novice – Open to members of any BHS Affiliated Riding Club or BHS Gold Members. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 70cm except for brush. Trophy to the winner.	CRC - £30 Non-members - £35
4	Pony Club Intermediate – Open to Pony Club Members only. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 85cm except for brush.	£30
5	Intermediate - Open to members of any BHS Affiliated Riding Club or BHS Gold Members. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 85cm except for brush. Trophy to the winner.	CRC - £30 Non-members - £35
6	Pony Club Open – Open to Pony Club Members only. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 85cm except for brush.	£30
7	Open – Open to members of any BHS Affiliated Riding Club or BHS Gold Members. Course to be approx. 2.4km with approx. 15 obstacles up to 1m except for brush. Trophy to the winner.	CRC - £30 Non-members - £35
8	Rusty Novice – Open to Rusty Riders, Beginners and Young Horses. Course will have approx. 10 obstacles up to 55cm. Trophy to the winner.	CRC - £25 Non-members - £30

Note: We respectively ask that competitors enter classes at their level, to be fair to all members who are taking part. However, you can enter HC in lower classes, if you wish. It is at the committee's discretion to move you into the open section (if entering restricted classes) if you are deemed to be over qualified for the class. Entries can be made via Equo Events or by cheque.

- Rosettes will be awarded from 1st through to 6th place in all classes. Classes with trophies have been identified on the schedule;
- Only one class per Horse and Rider Combination. If you enter the Eventers Challenge you will automatically be entered into the Autumn Hunter Trails;
- Horses competing in this event must be 5 years or older;
- These competitions will count towards the CRC Points Trophy & Turnout Trophy (HC entries will not be counted towards the Points);
- The X/C course will be available to walk on Saturday 31st August 2019 from 2pm onwards. Show Jumping Course will be available to walk on the day of the competition;
- Refunds for pre-entries will only be given before the closing date or with a viable reason for withdrawal;
- Times will be available on the website on Thursday 29th August 2019.
- Medical Armbands, Back Protectors and Peakless Hats are compulsory for the X/C element of this event;
- Please ensure you have referred to the BRC rules with regards to Hat and Back Protector Standards, which can be found on the website. Spot checks will be carried out and those who are non-compliant will not be allowed to ride.
